Just before the widely predicted huge Labour majority in the general election, not much more than a year ago, Labour went on an all-out charm offensive to businesses. Such were the promises made that there was a growing belief that, this time, when elected, there would be a business and growth-focussed Labour government. Such was the rhetoric that many prominent business leaders pledged their support for this new positive direction of travel and even British Chambers of Commerce who, on our behalf, lobbied strongly and presented to the Government in waiting many apparently acceptable pro-business policies, was sure that Labour was listening and more to the point, heeding. Maybe even the Labour leadership had not realised that the strength of their majority would bring into play so prominently such a backbench driven strongly socialist-biased Parliament. Many in business were aware that despite 14 years in waiting, the Labour Party's ministerial talent pool was woefully thin in experience and depth and would therefore likely be a little naïve. And so it has proven, kicking off with the most politically inept winter fuel allowance catastrophe, followed by dogged determination to introduce the anti-employment Workers Rights Bill and then the disastrous anti-business, anti-employment, anti-growth Budget with its swingeing £40 billion increase in employers NI. How many jobs have been lost as a result, how many not created, how many investments put on hold or even cancelled is a statistician's heaven.

What an unprecedented, shambolic run-up to the Autumn Budget, held at the latest date possible, itself causing huge problems in board rooms and financial institutions round the land, (and I expect no sympathy even leaving me with a print deadline of 2 hours after the Chancellor sat down!). With Parliamentary protocols largely bypassed, has there ever been so much confusion, so many leaked policies, formal announcements and U-turns over perhaps the longest ever pre-Budget build up? Bizarre and incompetent sums it up for me. To cap it all the OBR accidentally released the full analysis of the Budget a few hours before the Chancellor's speech, giving all the media and the Opposition time to prepare considered analysis and responses. One simply could not make it up! There proved to be nothing in the Budget statement that hadn't, in one way or another, been leaked. The Budget does nothing of real substance that is helpful to business, rather a further burden, particularly to the hospitality and retail sectors specifically due to the minimum wage changes. With such a backloaded Budget I contend that there is little likelihood in future years of today's forecasted projections bearing any resemblance to the actual situation (we have all done business plans!).


So, what will subsequent Budgets bring? It will be of no surprise that I suggest they will be on the back of little growth in the economy, a stalled housing market, stubborn inflation, rising unemployment, immigration legal and illegal a hot topic and business confidence all but evaporated. The only certainty is that taxes and benefits will continue rise, but to whose net benefit? Certainly, I suggest neither business nor 'working people'. The not so merry-go-round will spin long after this Budget with the inevitable unintended consequences, more U-turns and Parliamentary disarray and when reading this some of those things will already be playing out. To me there seems only one solution, but that is at least two years away! What untold damage to the economy in the meantime? Meanwhile irrespective, business will do its best to prosper.

Is this all too gloomy? Then brighten up with a bit of introspection and think on the opportunities arising from the major projects approved and in process in our County. We arguably have more prospects for business than anywhere else in the country, so support your Chamber in supporting you to realise these opportunities for Bedfordshire businesses and Bedfordshire people. Our businesses will continue to find a way irrespective.

Quarterly ECONOMIC SURVEY REPORT

Bedfordshire Chamber of Commerce Quarterly Economic Survey (QES) forms part of the British Chamber of Commerce's national survey and is the principal business survey in the UK. Its results are closely watched by both the Bank of England's Monetary Policy Committee and the Treasury. The data reveals a timely and accurate snapshot of the economic climate for businesses in Bedfordshire and beyond.

Q3 2025 Findings

Confidence flatlining ahead of the budget:

Confidence remains flat, with only 30% of businesses reported an increase in domestic sales during the second quarter of 2025, a slight improvement on Q2 results, while 46% saw no change and a further 26% experienced a decline.

Overseas Markets: Overseas export performance bounced back from a challenging period, with 20% of businesses reporting an increase in sales compared to just 6% in in Q2 2025. 30% saw a decline in sales. Global headwinds such as exchange rates, inflation and the tariff challenges have affected the order book with respondents' forward sales indicate nearly 40% anticipate a decline in international orders in Q4 2025.

Workforce & Recruitment: Nearly 1 in 4 (22%) of firms recruited in the third quarter of the year, with 59% of respondents reporting no change in headcount but 19% reduced their staff numbers in this period. Looking ahead, businesses anticipate similar workforce stability, with only 8% expecting reductions in staff and 69% predicting no growth in recruitment.

Investment: Overall, just 6% of local companies reported increased investment in plant and machinery during the last quarter, 6% reported no change, and 27% reported a decrease. Over the same period, investment plans for training contracted by eight percentage points, with 73% of respondents expecting their training commitments to remain unchanged and only one in ten are looking to increase their training spend.

Cost Pressures: It comes as no surprise that labour costs remain the leading concern for local businesses. Alongside this, rising overheads and energy prices continue to place significant strain on companies and are limiting their ability to invest. Following the recent Budget and increases to employer National Insurance contributions, many respondents who anticipated higher wage costs, reduced recruitment plans, and more modest pay settlements for existing staff have, unfortunately, seen those concerns materialise

Outlook: Despite the announcement of nearly £12 billion in investment heading to the county during the survey period, confidence among our respondents - predominantly SMEs declined sharply. Many are now significantly less optimistic about improvements in turnover and profitability over the next 12 months.

The Bottom Line

Responding to the findings, Head of Research at the British Chambers of Commerce, David Bharier, said:

"Ahead of the Chancellor's statement next month, our survey shows many firms remain bruised and are not ready for another Budget battering. The research reveals no clear improvements to key indicators we track. For twelve months, SMEs have told us the same story: rising costs, weak investment, and little sense of relief on the horizon.

"The Employer NICs increase has been the most widely cited source of pressure, hitting investment and pushing up prices. The proportion of businesses expecting to raise prices remains worryingly high, driven primarily by labour costs. Inflation now sits alongside taxation as a top concern. The global shift towards protectionism and tariffs has also been a major compounding factor.

"Persistent weak sentiment this quarter may suggest that many firms have already priced in a tough Budget. But further surprise measures that hit business, like those seen in 2024, could drive confidence even lower.

"What businesses need now is certainty and a long-term strategy, not more ad hoc policy shifts. The AI revolution could be a real productivity game changer and our recent research shows that more SMEs are adopting it, but firms need the space to invest and adapt if the UK is to seize the opportunity.

"Our message to the Chancellor ahead of the Budget is clear - no further tax rises on business. SMEs are calling for urgent action to tackle skills shortages, a bold push to boost exports, and more investment in infrastructure. Without that, confidence could deteriorate further, putting economic growth at risk"

Its expert Family Support Team offers practical guidance and emotional care, working closely with schools, healthcare professionals, and researchers to ensure everyone with Rett syndrome can live the best life possible.

CEO Robert Adamek reflects: "Rett UK started as parents searching for answers and connection. Forty years on, we've become a lifeline for hundreds of families, but our mission remains the same: no one should face Rett syndrome alone."

The charity receives no government funding, relying entirely on donations and grants. Parent Emma shares:

"Rett UK has been with us since Olivia's diagnosis four years ago, helping with school, communication, and emotional support. They've made us feel so much less alone."

LIFE-CHANGING PROSTHETICS

for Cancer and Trauma Survivors in Leighton Buzzard

A new specialist medical clinic has opened in Leighton Buzzard, offering life-changing support to patients living with the lasting effects of cancer, trauma, or congenital

Engreco Healthcare, founded by award-winning maxillofacial prosthetist Anna Veli, provides bespoke facial and body prostheses, including artificial eyes, ears, noses, and post-mastectomy breast and nipple prosthetics. It is one of only a handful of independent clinics in the UK dedicated to this highly specialised field.

This year marks a major milestone for Engreco as the business moved into its first purpose-built premises. The site has been fully transformed into a state-of-the-art clinic and laboratory, with a compliant medical surgery, disabilityfriendly facilities, and advanced 3D printing equipment for prosthetic design and manufacture.

After more than a decade in senior NHS roles, Anna launched Engreco Healthcare to provide timely, personalised care for patients who often face long waits or limited treatment options in hospital settings.

"Many of our patients have been waiting months or years for NHS support," says Anna. "Others have been told there's nothing more that can be done at their local Trust. At Engreco, we offer them another path, one of restoration, dignity, and hope."

Engreco is also proud of its social commitment: offering 50% discounts to veterans and members of the armed forces, alongside pro bono care for underserved patients. The clinic is pioneering work in gender-affirming prosthetics, an area rarely addressed in mainstream healthcare.






